brushes

soft haired, synthetic brushes are a good place to start

- round brush—size 14, 10, and 8 to start

- filbert brush—size 1"

- square brush—size ¾", ½"
- sponge brushes—size 1", 2"
- decorators brushes from hardware store—various sizes
- mild soap for cleaning brushes

watercolor mediums

watercolor pan set-great for a beginner

watercolor tubes

gouache

inks:

- water soluble inks-easy to layer and can be reactivated to various degrees with water
- permanent dye inks-waterproof, cannot be reactivated by water
